When counting out your objects, placing the items in groups of 10 and counting by 10's sometimes makes the task easier. (We are working on seeing groups of 10's and counting by 10's in class.)

These collections do take some time and you might need to enlist the help from grandparents, neighbors in your collections, so begin early to think of an idea and begin collecting and counting. :)

Collections are due on Wednesday, Feb 5. PLEASE DO NOT SEND ANY COLLECTIONS INTO SCHOOL PRIOR TO THIS DATE.
