


OUR CLASS RULES

Our Classroom Rules/Management

Our classroom is a small community of learners where we all are expected to work as a team and good relationships are expected. We will spend time learning class procedures/rules and practicing them throughout the year.

Each kinder is expected to act within our class created "Classroom Contract/Promises". The kinders will be guided to respect themselves and others through continued reference to our classroom contract/promises. This contract will be created within the first weeks of school together. The kinders and myself will work together to answer the following questions:

How do you want to be treated by the teacher?

How do you want to be treated by each other?

How do you think your teacher wants to be treated by you?

How do you want to treat each other when there is conflict?

The classroom promises are reinforced throughout the year by the kinders holding each other accountable and providing feedback on how we are doing as a group. I will use the following questions with a kinder when a kinder is not making a positive choice:

What are you doing?

What are you supposed to be doing?

What are you going to do to change your behavior?

In our classroom community we will build meaningful relationships and hold each other accountable to our personal best. I will also use a non-verbal check signal (side ways thumbs up) to a kinder that needs a little redirection before I ask them the 3 questions.
